




Steve Ward (Frank Butler)

Helen McDuffee 1914-2004

FROM THE DIRECTOR

What a thrill to direct this fantastic cast in *Annie Get Your Gun*! Putting this production together was truly a collaborative effort. Debbie Ward commuted from Indianapolis for nearly every rehearsal to help the singers and orchestra members brilliantly interpret Irving Berlin's memorable score. Angie Mansfield worked magic in bringing the musical numbers to life. And my dearest friend of more than 30 years, Mary Lou Spain, assisted by adding many fine touches that give all the scenes extra sparkle.

The directing staff could not have succeeded, however, without the efficiency and tireless efforts of producer, Gary Lickfett and stage manager, Tom Fricke. David Woodrow deserves special thanks for creating the basic concept for the set design and for sharing many helpful ideas.

DLO has presented *Annie Get Your Gun* twice before. The 1961 show was the version in which Ethel Merman created the role of Annie Oakley in 1946. The 1977 revival was a slightly revised version that Merman had done at Lincoln Center in 1966. The current show is the major revision in which Bernadette Peters opened on Broadway in 1999.

Ginny Summers Konieczki (DLO's Annie Oakley, 1961) has traveled all the way back from her home in Columbus, Mississippi, and Danville resident, Tobi Baer Peck (Annie Oakley, 1977) has come directly from her role in Red Mask's *Web of Murder* to celebrate DLO's 50th season by making cameo appearances in this production.
