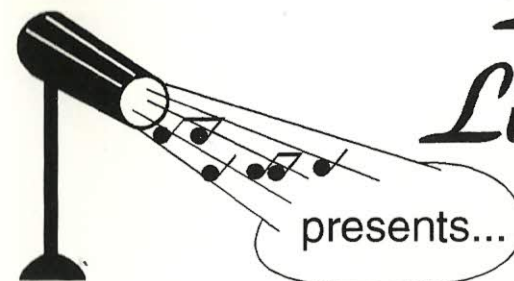

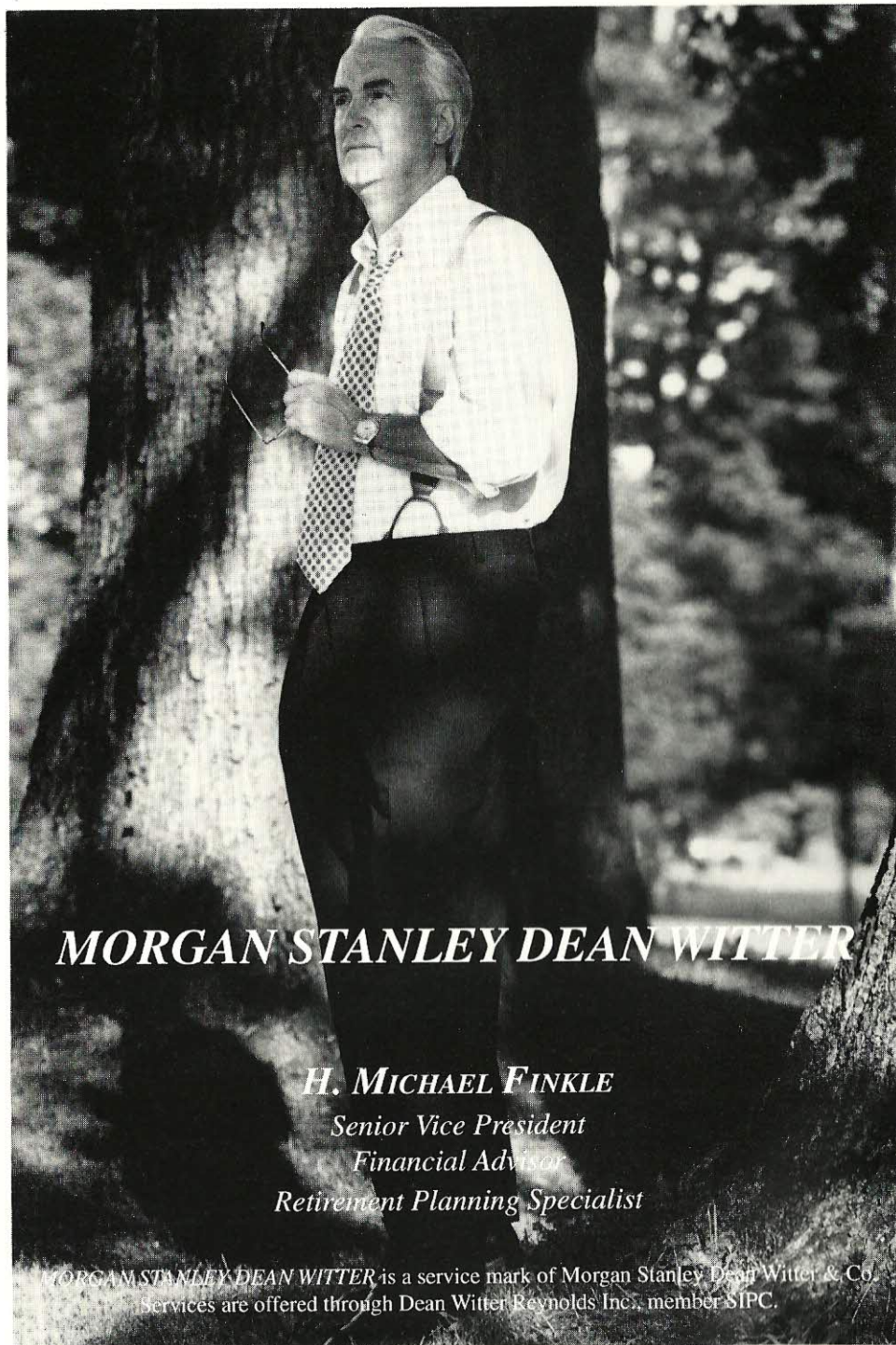

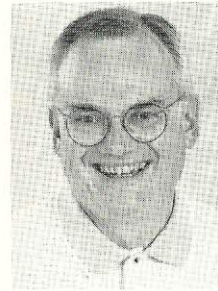
Eric France (Simon Whitehead)

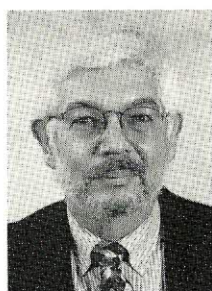
Nancy Livingston (Sheila Kelly)

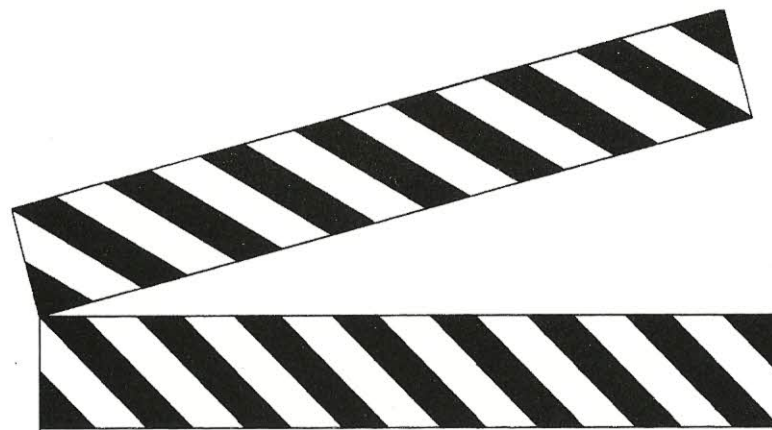


Dudley (Sandy)
