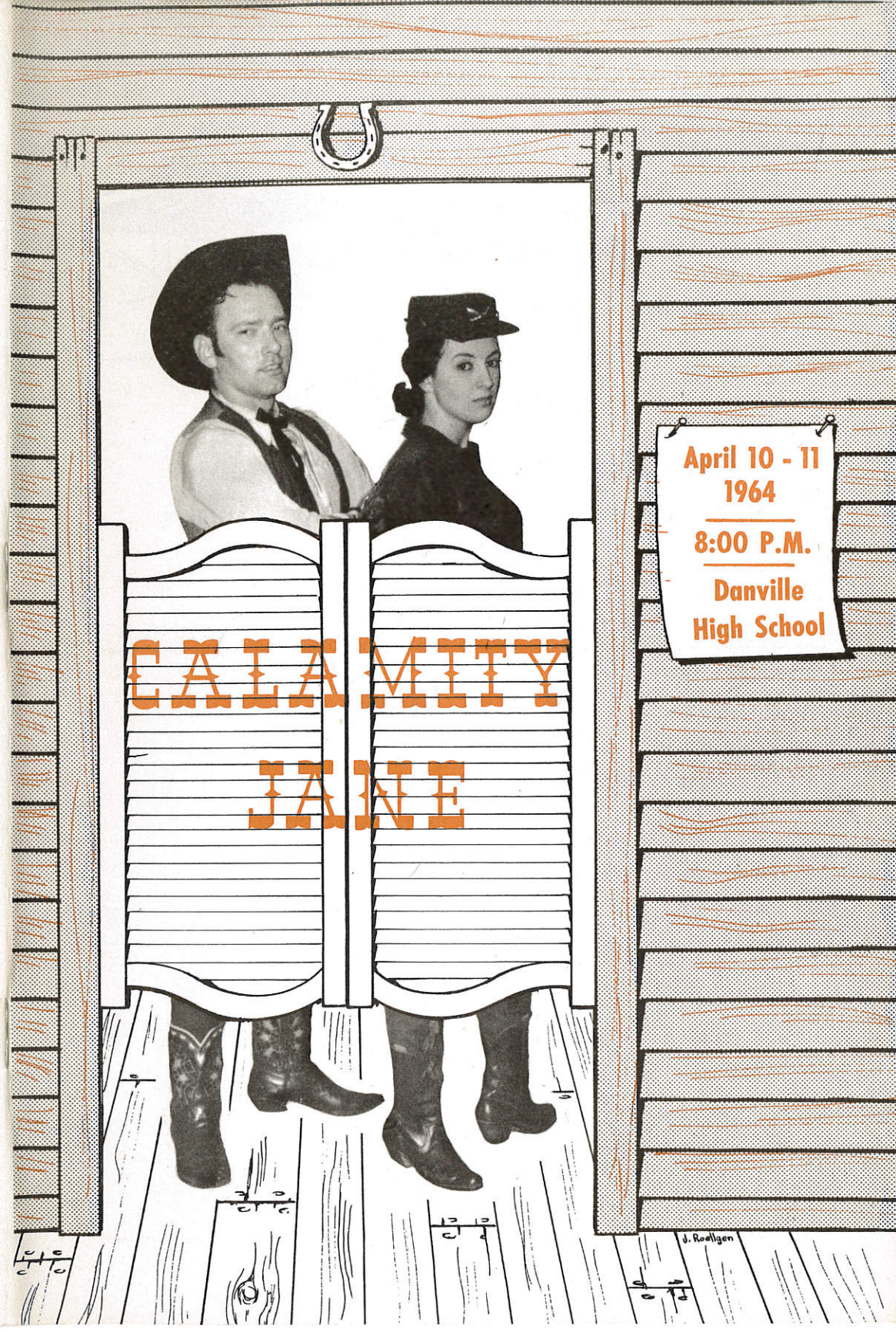

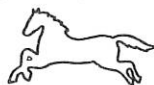

MORE ABOUT "CALAMITY JANE"

Rare indeed is the Broadway musical that isn't filmed and distributed as widely as kind censors will permit. "Calamity Jane" is that rarity of a film trying to work its way to Broadway. Although it hasn't happened yet, it has attracted such stars as Edie Adams, Martha Raye, and Carol Burnett, and played from Pittsburgh to Fort Worth, and from St. Louis to Indiana.

The story of "Calamity Jane" is more than a little based on fact. In the 1870's gold was discovered in the high black hills near Deadwood City, in the Sioux infested Dakota Territory. Many came to those black hills in search of fortune, but few found more than a meager homestake.

Deadwood was an exciting town, and two of its most colorful citizens were Mary Jane Canary and Bill Hickok. Mary Jane has become immortalized as the famed "Calamity Jane," and it has been said that the United States government found it necessary to keep a whole regiment of soldiers at nearby Fort Scully just to watch over the activities of Wild Bill Hickok.

So fasten your seat belts, for you are about to see and hear the rootin'est, tootin'est musical this side of Broadway, U.S.A.
