Music: KENT PARRISH graduated from the music department at Illinois State University in 1976. During his course of study he has appeared in major roles in "H.M.S. Pinafore," "Brigadoon," and "The Mikado," and in 1976 performed as tenor soloist in the production of Handel's "Messiah." He has toured with the Illinois State University Concert Choir, Men's Glee Club, and the nationally recognized Madrigal Singers. Mr. Parrish is in his second year of teaching music in the Catlin Unit Schools where he directs the high school and elementary school choirs. In October 1977, he directed the grade school choirs in the production of the new youth musical "It's Music!"

Choreographer: JAMIE M. BRIGGS, this multitalented lady is our choreographer for the third time. She has served DLO in many capacities since she appeared in her first show in 1961: President/show coordinator, stage manager, costumer, choreographer, singer, actress, and dancer. She has been in 11 DLO productions, most notably as the "Unsinkable Molly Brown", Ellie, the dancer in "Show Boat" and Eve in "Applause". Jamie attended Indiana University. Appeared in operas there; Summer Repertory Theater at U of I, Stage One Dinner Theater, and Danville Junior Woman's Club Follies. Last summer Jamie was seen as the Baroness in Sunshine II's "Sound of Music" and is currently rehearsing for their dinner theatre production of "Jacques Brel is Alive and Well—" to be given in July. Jamie just received the Annual Red Mask's "Katy" Award for Best Actress for her performance in "Janus".
