

Other plays which Faye has choreographed include: Red Mill, Carousel, Oliver, Music Man, The King and I, The Sound of Music, and Desert Song in which she also danced in the part of Azuri. Faye is owner and director of Faye's Dance Company at 3636 N. Vermilion. She is married to Robert Willett and has a daughter, Maryfrances Flynn.

LOU' CROCKETT (Stage Manager) — has participated in dramatic productions in high school and at the University of Illinois, where she has earned a B.S. in Secondary Education. She has shared her talent with several schools in School District 118 over the years. Recently she was seen on Channel 11 presenting poetry written by Black poets. She also enjoyed working with the last DLO production, *The Sound of Music.* Lou' is married to Fred Crockett and is the mother of 5 children including a real David Crockett.


