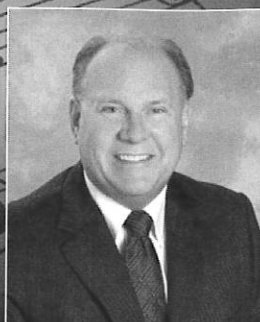

## A Note from the Director

One hundred years ago, Swedish poet and playwright Hjalmar Söderberg wrote that the only absolutes in life are "the desire of the flesh and the incurable loneliness of the soul." A Little Night Music—a story of mismatched couples who eventually find their way to their true loves, re-discovering themselves in the process—explores these themes, providing twists and turns which are often humorous, at times sad, but always entertaining. Middle-aged lawyer Fredrik Egerman sings "I still want and/or love you" to his young wife, Anne, a virgin after nearly a year of marriage. The actress Desiree Armfeldt, though surrounded by admirers, longs for a more "coherent existence" with a husband. Neglected Charlotte attempts to win back her dallying count while preserving what's left of her self-esteem. Petra, the maid, intends on sowing some wild oats before marrying the miller's son. Seminary student Henrik lives in a state of "perpetual anticipation," ashamed of his prurient urges. As the plot carries us to a magical summer night in the Swedish countryside at the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, it is young Fredrika who understands the moral: love is both the problem and the solution because "it's all there is."

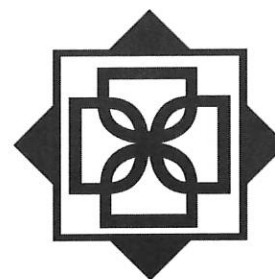
