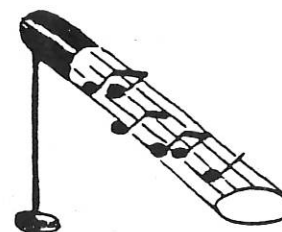

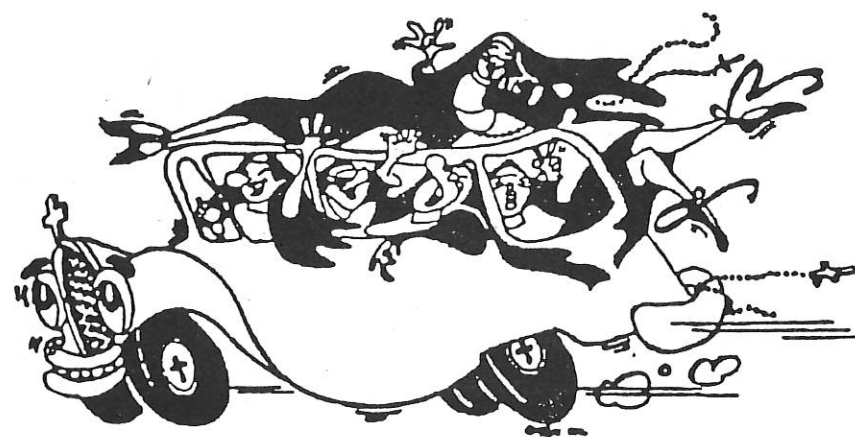

PROFILES

NANCY HENDERSON (Sister Amnesia (Mary Paul))

Nancy has been with DLO for five years now and has been involved in various theatre projects since high school, including a stint with the Kankakee Valley Theatre before she and her family moved to Danville. One of her all-time favorite parts is that of Sister Amnesia which she played in the original *Nunsense* and she also lists *Man of LaMancha*, *Into the Woods* and *The Music Man* among her favorite performances. Nancy and her husband Lon have two sons, Nathan and Erick, and she teaches at Danville High.

JAN MARKEN (Sister Mary Regina)

Jan returns as Sister Mary Regina from *Nunsense* and cites this as one of her favorite parts in 17 years with DLO. Jan directed the DLO Dinner Theatre production of *The Butler Did It, Singing* in 1993 and has also contributed to numerous shows in many ways such as props, stage managing and production. She was previously seen in *Steel Magnolias*, *The Unsinkable Molly Brown*, *Carousel* and *1940's Radio Hour*. Jan works in customer service at Tee Pak and she and husband Dave have two children, Michele and Nathan.

CARLA MODGLIN (Sister Mary Leo)

Carla is the newcomer to the *Nunsense* contingent and she has certainly enjoyed working with the "sisters" this winter. Carla was last seen in the 1993 production of *Red Hot and Cole* for the Champaign-Urbana Theatre Company and she cites her favorite DLO roles in *Anything Goes* and as a vocalist in *The All Night Strut!*. She has been involved with DLO for 10 years and is currently serving on the DLO Board. Carla teaches Chapter One Reading at East Park Elementary School.

BELINDA SMITH (Sister Mary Hubert)

Belinda was also cast in the original DLO production of *Nunsense* and has been looking forward to bringing Sister Mary Hubert back to the stage. Belinda has been involved in many diverse vocal groups since her high school years including various choirs and madrigal singers and she also directed the high school adaptations of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* and *Godspell*. Belinda is the Vocal Music Director at Catlin Grade School and thanks her family — Larry, Andrew and Lauren — for their tremendous support during her preparation for *Nunsense II*.

KATHLEEN SPAIN-SWIERSZ (Sister Robert Anne)

Kathleen is a twenty year veteran of Danville Light Opera and has contributed countless hours to DLO while wearing many different hats. She directed the DLO production of *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* last fall and last appeared as Carrie Pipperidge in *Carousel*. She also played major roles in *A Day In Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine* and *Pirates of Penzance* for DLO and also performed for the Red Mask Players (*Reckless*) and The Window Repertory Theatre (*Shadowbox*). Kathleen has produced, conducted and played in various orchestras, directed drama, music and choreographed many shows including *Do Patent Leather Shoes Really Reflect Up?* and *Pump Boys and Dinettes*. She has been looking forward to the opportunity to dance in some major numbers without having to choreograph as well. Kathleen is a Chapter One math teacher at Daniel School and enjoys the terrific support of her husband, Mike.

KEVIN LATOZ (Music Director)

Kevin also returns for the second coming of the Nuns as Music Director, a title he has had in several productions in his five years with Danville Light Opera. Among his favorite shows are *The All Night Strut!*, *Little Shop of Horrors* (in which he was the keyboardist) and he was Associate Producer of *Man of LaMancha*. High on Kevin's wish list for future projects is *City of Angels* and *Tommy*. Kevin and his wife, Kristi, have a son, Lucas and he is employed by Nacco Materials Handling Group.

JIM KNOBLAUCH (Director)

Jim directed the original *Nunsense* and he has found that his involvement with both *Nunsense* productions has allowed him "to release years of pent up hostility due to 12 years of Catholic school!" He also directed *Reckless* for the Red Mask Players and *A Day in Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine* for DLO.
