"Once Upon a Mattress" is an innocent little charade based on a familiar fairy tale.

It is a modern retelling of the old story about the princess so delicate that she couldn't sleep on a pile of mattresses because a pea had been placed beneath the one at the bottom. The librettists aren't taken in by the legend of the lady's excessive delicacy. They are convinced that some skulduggery was afoot.

In their version of the fable it seems that the princess, bent on marrying Prince Dauntless, arrived at the castle by swimming the moat, could lift a great dumbbell with one hand, and in general, knew how to take care of herself. But the wicked Queen, who thought up the mattress test for her might have been too much for the girl if the court jester, a strolling minstrel and dashing knight, hadn't tricked the villainess.

Naturally, Prince Dauntless is an amiable lout terrified by his baleful mother, while his good-natured father, the King, is so bullied by the evil Queen



that he has lost his voice. They get back at the lady in the end, though, putting her properly in her place. This is a show of high spirits.




