


Marry Me A Little

Director's Notes

Two decades ago, in era when Broadway musicals nearly always shouted, "She Loves Me," which opened on April 23, 1963, chose to speak softly—almost *mezza voce*. And that is why this intimate, charming show has been such a delight to bring together. This story of a young man and a young woman, their spirted bickering in a fancy perfume shop, and their transcendent, but disembodied, love affair via the post office, has a long history. Hungarian play-wright Miklos Laszlo created a play called "Parfumerie", a tremendous success produced in seventeen countries and translated into eleven languages. In 1940, M-G-M brought the film version, "The Shop Around the Corner, to the screen, directed by Ernst Lubitsch, and starring James Stewart, Margaret Sullavan and Frank Morgan. Finally, in the early 60's, writer Joe Masteroff, producer Harold Prince, and composers Jerry Bock and Sheldon Harnick, all responsible for a later "minor" hit called "Fiddler on the Roof," began to lay the groundwork for a musical which would eventually open to rave reviews with a cast headed by the legendary Barbara Cook.

In writing the score, Bock and Harnick strove to capture the warmth and intimacy of the original play. Subsequently, almost ninety per cent of the music is sung by individuals; there are few emsemble numbers. There is a subtle—at times extraordinary—blending of music and drama. The eloquent use of song as soliloquy and self-portrait, of underscore as comment and interior revelation, and of music as emotional ambience is remarkable. Jerry Bock once shared, "Sheldon and I simply wanted to do a romantic show. We've never written so tenderly before." Such is the magic of this valentine-like work.

"She Loves Me" is a delicate, lyrical musical, especially appropriate for spring when love is in the air. We hope you will find a little of its warmth, a bit of its magic. Welcome to Maraczek's. Thank you for coming and please call again, won't you?






