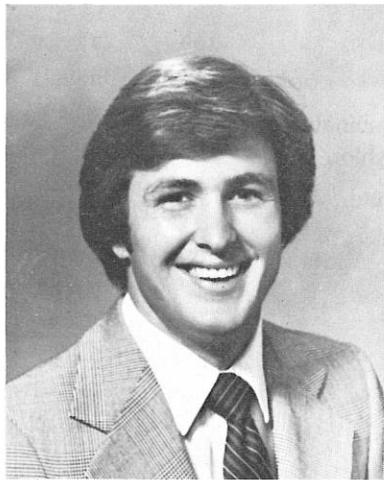

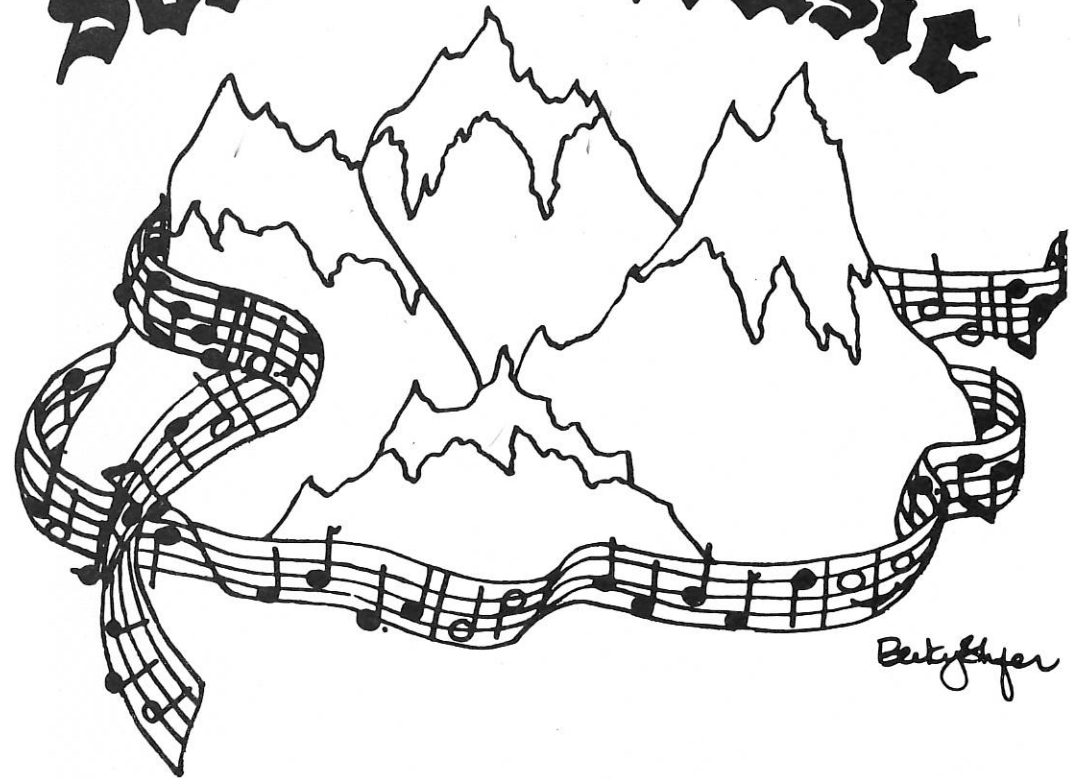

SYNOPSIS – "THE SOUND OF MUSIC"

The hills are alive with *THE SOUND OF MUSIC*! Probably no other title song so perfectly describes its "home show" as does this one! Rodgers and Hammerstein's delightfully wedded music and lyrics fit, as if born, to this true story of Maria, the young postulant nun, who leaves the convent to become governess of the children of the autocratic army captain, Baron Von Trapp. Despite the difference in their ages, and his previous betrothal to the Countess Elsa, Maria and the Baron soon fall in love and are married. Their friend Max transforms the new family into the Von Trapp Singers, and they are rapidly becoming famous when they are forced by the Nazis to flee Austria.

Theatre-goers everywhere have always benefitted from this story of fortitude and courage, and remembered the advice of Maria's Mother Abbess to "Climb Every Mountain".

She danced professionally with the Merriel Abbott Dancers in Chicago and is a member of Chicago National Association of Dance Masters. She has been involved in DLO productions, beginning in 1960 with *South Pacific*. Other plays which Faye has choreographed include: *Red Mill*, *Carousel*, *Oliver*, *Music Man*, *The King and I*, and *Desert Song* in which she also danced in the part of Azuri. Faye is owner and director of Faye's Dance Company at 3636 N. Vermilion. She is married to Robert Willett and has a daughter, Maryfrances Flynn.

JOHN R. ORSULAK (Stage Manager) – John has been active with DLO for the past three years, as an actor and on production staffs. 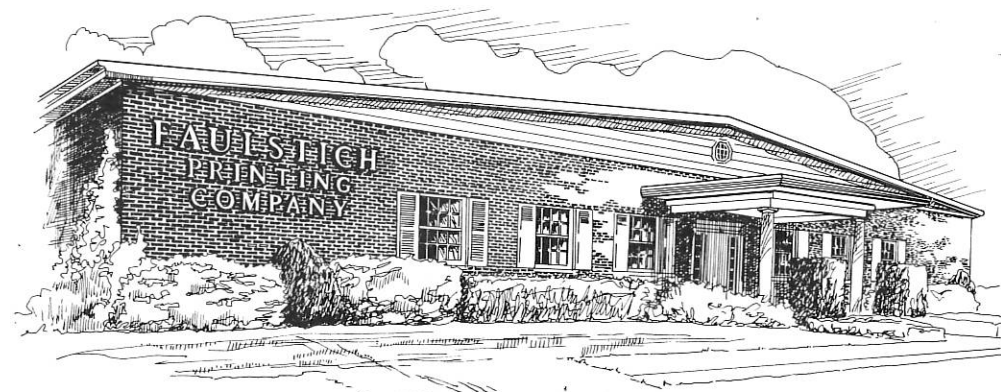

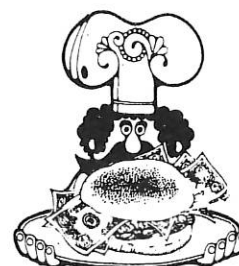

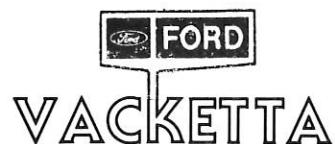

She has been President, producer, stage manager, costume designer, choreographer, actress/singer, and dancer. She has appeared in 11 DLO productions, most notably as *The Unsinkable Molly Brown*. Her credits also include opera at Indiana University, Summer Repertory Theatre at U of I, Stage One Dinner Theatre, Junior Women's Club Follies and Sunshine II Ltd. She is the recipient of the Red Mask "Katy" award for her performance in *Janus*. Jamie works at the Danville Country Club, is a part-time college student, and mother of two children.

ROBYN BRIGGS (Liesl) — is also a DLO veteran having appeared, most recently, in *West Side Story* and as King Simon in the ballet of *The King and I*. At North Ridge Junior High, Robyn was a member of the Mixed Choir and the Red Coats Swing Choir. She also won several speech and drama awards during her three years there. Robyn is a member of Central Christian Church and teaches in the Summer Parish Music Program. She is a sophomore at DHS and works as a student demonstrator at the Cromwell School of Dance.

STEVE BYRKET (Rolf) — with a background in music and drama, this is Steve's third show with DLO. He is a senior at DHS and a member of the Singing Vikings, Contemporaires, and the Drama Club. Steve studies piano (jazz and classical), dance and voice to prepare him for college. 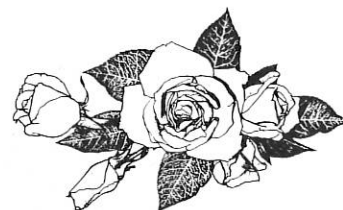

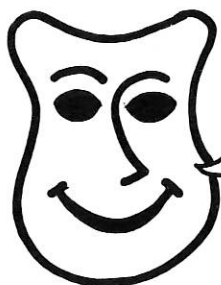

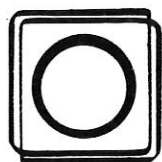
